***NAIDOC Week**, is an Australian observance lasting from the first Sunday in July until the following Sunday. The acronym NAIDOC stands for National Aborigines and Islanders Day Observance Committee, which was originally National Aborigines Day Observance Committee (NADOC). NAIDOC Week has its roots in the 1938 [Day of Mourning](#), becoming a week-long event in 1975.

NAIDOC Week celebrates the history, culture and achievements of [Aboriginal](#) and [Torres Strait Islander](#) people. The week is celebrated not just in the [Indigenous Australian](#) communities but also in increasing numbers of government agencies, schools, local councils and workplaces.

End of Term Arrangements

Term 2 finishes on Friday 7/07/2023. Formal lessons will finish on Thursday 6/07/2023 at the normal dismissal time of 3:00pm.


Term 3
