Student Goals

Material and Services fee 2026

Bowden Brompton Community School is committed to providing a quality educational experience for all students. To ensure we can continue delivering a broad range of resources and services, we are informing you of the Materials and Services Charges for the 2026 school year.

In alignment with the prescribed base charges, the Materials and Services Fees for 2026 will be as follows:

Primary Students:

\$306.00

Secondary Students:

\$403.00

The proposed charges for Bowden Brompton Community School, are reflective of the prescribed amount as set out in Regulation 81 for the Education and Children's Services Regulations that schools can charge as a compulsory component, without the requirement to poll the school community for the 2026 school year and are therefore fully legally recoverable.

As you will see from the notices, the school fees contribute to the provision of materials, equipment and access to school services relative to the 2026 school year.

Years R-6 M&S charges are set at \$306, and the Years 7-12 M&S Charges are set at \$403.

The Government M&S rebate for 2026 has been set at \$200 for each eligible student liable for the M&S charges, bringing the out-of-pocket expenses down to \$106 for R-6 students, and \$203 for 7-12 students.

As a part of the process, we are inviting you to provide feedback regarding the proposed school fees, either:

- In writing, to the Torrens Road Front Office or to the email address below, by Thursday 30th
 October; or
- By attending a Governing Council Meeting, on Monday 3rd November at 2pm at Bowden Brompton Community School, Torrens Road Campus. Please contact the front office by Thursday 30th October advising your intention to attend on (08) 8346 4041.

It will be at this Governing Council meeting, where the charge will be discussed, and approval sought by the Governing Council.
