## **BBCS ENROLMENT PROCESS**

### **Students under 16 years of age:**

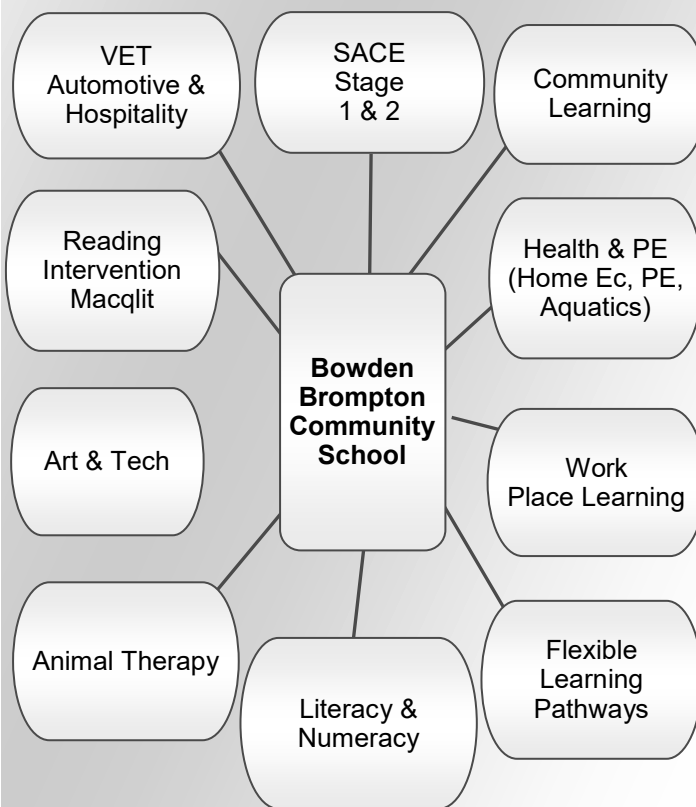
Students under 16 years of age are referred by a Department for Education assigned Behaviour Coach (BC) who consults with the current school and the family. The Behaviour Coach arranges the enrolment meeting through the appropriate Head of Campus.

### **Students 16 to 17 years of age:**

Students over 16 years of age may self enrol at the school. Enrolment is dependent on available places. Enrolment is conditional on attending an interview appointment and a clear mapping of learning goals to be achieved within the school's SACE and VET curriculum.

## **PROGRAMS CAN INCLUDE ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:**

### **MIDDLE SCHOOLING (Year 8 & 9)**

Timetabled lessons covering the 7 required areas of learning in the South Australian Curriculum Standards and Accountability Framework.

### **SENIOR SCHOOLING (Year 10, 11 & 12)**

A variety of SACE subjects are offered each semester.

### **VET**

Vocational programmes run in conjunction with TAFE e.g. Automotive, Disabled / Aged Care & Hospitality.

### **TRANSITION PROGRAM**

A programme designed to support students to gain necessary skills to move to employment or other options.

### **WORKPLACE LEARNING**

Including Work Experience, Work Shadowing, Work Observation and/or 'on the job' Training.

### **FLEXIBLE LEARNING PATHWAYS**

Literacy & Numeracy Support, Short Courses, Re-engagement Programs, Personal Development Programs, TAFE Transition Programs & SACE options
